Tournament Conditions

- The committee shall have the entire management of the tournament.
- The Entry Fee must be paid to the Treasurer before playing.
- Play commences 9.00am Saturday, 8.30am Sunday & Monday
- Players must be ready for play when called upon, otherwise they will be scratched.
- The committee reserves the right to re-grade any players on or after their nominations.
- The Tournament will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations laid down by Tennis NSW, except as altered by the Programme and these conditions.
- Tie breakers will be played according to the 12 point tie-breaker system.
- Players cannot enter more than four events and can only play in three events on the final day. Players may only enter in two consecutive grades. The committee reserves the right to decide which grade any player must play.
- The committee reserves the right to cancel any event if entries for any grade be insufficient, or if there be not sufficient time.
- The committee reserves the right to conduct the tournament under lights.
- Players must not delay matches. Players who, if after caution from the umpire, continue to delay a match shall be disqualified by the Tournament Referee and the match awarded to the opponents.
- Competitors must state the name of their club and give evidence of their previous performances.
- In Open Events, new balls may be requested by either or both players for the 3rd set only.
- Used balls may be used in events 11 to 49.
- Players must appear in regular tennis attire.
- Prize money will be awarded to all Winners and Runners Up in all events, except Junior and Family Events who shall receive trophies.
- Minimum age for veterans' doubles events is 40 years and must be a combined total of 110+.
- ALL OPEN EVENTS TO BE PLAYED ON LOAM COURTS WEATHER PERMITTING.
- Due to sponsorship responsibilities, no trophies/prize money will be awarded before the presentation ceremony at approximately 4pm Monday.
