TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

Players are advised to retain this part of the entry form for their own information, noting the entry conditions.

Age Eligibility: Entrants in junior events must supply their birth dates and produce their birth certificates if requested. Eligibility for junior events is based on the player's age as at 31st August 2009.

Withdrawals: Players who withdraw from an event on or after 13th August, 2009, or withdraw from an event during the tournament, will be penalised under the TA and MA Events Disciplinary Policy, except in those cases where a medical certificate or other reasonable cause is provided for non-participation. Withdrawal notification must be in writing and submitted to the tournament director immediately. Evidence in support of the withdrawal (ie. medical certificate etc) must be submitted to the tournament director within seven days of the withdrawal notification.

Entries: No player shall be permitted to enter in more than two events; and if entered in two events, one must be a doubles. Entrants may only play in one age group.

Matches: In all main draw singles events, events shall be played using the knockout format and all matches shall be the best-of-three sets. In any set, if the score reaches six games all, a tiebreak shall be played to determine the winner of the set. All doubles events shall be played using the knockout format. In any set, if the score reaches six games all, a tiebreak shall be played to determine the winner of the set. If the score reaches one set all, the deciding third set shall be replaced by one match tiebreak game (first to 10 points).

Consolation: Entries permitting, in all singles events, a sign-on consolation will be conducted. Details of the consolation event will be advertised at the tournament desk. Please check this upon arrival at the tournament. There will be no extra charge for this event.

Doubles: A player entering a doubles event without naming a partner shall accept the partner allocated by the committee, but this does not impose any obligation on the committee to find a partner.

Surface: Matches may be played on Synthetic Grass or Hardcourt.

Exemptions: Players must be available at all times during the tournament. No time exemptions will be granted.

Entry Fees: Entry fees must accompany the entry form.
