## TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

### CODE OF CONDUCT

1. This Tournament will be conducted in accordance with Tennis Australia's Member Protection By-law, these rules & regulations & the Tennis Australia Events Disciplinary Policy (each as amended from time to time).
2. I acknowledge that as a participant in a Tennis Australia sanctioned event I agree to comply with the ITF Rules of Play, the Tennis Australia Events Disciplinary Policy (including its reference to spectator behaviour & interference), the Tennis Australia Member Protection By-Law & the Tennis Australia Anti-Doping Policy.
3. Inappropriate spectator behaviour could result in denial of entry at future Tennis Australia or Member Association sanctioned events, & will be dealt with in accordance with these policies. This includes, but is not limited to tennis venues, hotels & transport vehicles.
4. I acknowledge that all Tennis Australia policies can be readily viewed at [www.tennis.com.au](http://www.tennis.com.au) & that it is my responsibility to view these & seek clarification, if required, from Tennis Australia.

### CONSENT

1. I consent to be involved in any publicity connected with a Tennis Australia Sanctioned Tournament, including media interviews, photographs & TV footage. Please inform the tournament organiser if you do not wish to be involved in publicity.
2. I consent to Tennis Australia &/or organisers of Tennis Australia sanctioned tournaments to use details provide on the entry form to communicate information about this & future tournaments, via post, email or SMS.

### RECOMMENDATION

1. It is recommended for every athlete to be a member of an affiliated tennis club within their state of residency.
2. As an entrant in this event, Tennis Australia recommends that your coach is a Tennis Australia certified coach. This will ensure that the coach has currently updated his/her coaching credentials, has been police checked & has an updated first aid qualification.

### REGISTRATION

1. All Open entrants are to be current registered playing members of Tennis Victoria or another member association & provide their Registered Player Number.

### WITHDRAWALS

1. The deadline for withdrawal without incurring any penalty is 14 days before the start of play of the tournament - i.e. 20th February 2010. Players will be penalised by the Code of Conduct if the Tournament Director does not receive withdrawal notification.

2. A medical certificate must support any withdrawals for health reasons. Withdrawals must be made in writing & presented to the Tournament Director by fax (02) 6056 2274 or emailed to [wltc@bigpond.com](mailto:wltc@bigpond.com).

### RULES OF PLAY

1. The committee shall have complete control & may make any decision it deems necessary to ensure the continuity of the tournament.
2. Matches will be played on the grasscourts, provided conditions & circumstances permit.
3. The use of ripple or bar soled shoes or heels, or spikes or bare feet is prohibited.
4. Regulation tennis attire must be worn.

### ENTRY LIMITS

Players may enter in up to 5 events. Players however should note the following:

1. There is no Feed In event for Open Singles.
2. There will be a Consolation event for junior doubles (the consolation event is not included in the 5 event limit).
3. Singles: Seeded players in an event will be ineligible for the corresponding event in a lower grade.
4. Players reaching a semi final or final in an event will be withdrawn from the corresponding event in a lower grade.
5. Players time of arrival on the first day will limit the number of events they can enter as follows:
  - a) Available at the start of day one - 5 events.
  - b) Not available until 11:00am - 4 events.
  - c) Not available until 1:00pm - 3 events
4. An exemption for late arrival for Saturday matches may be granted at the discretion of the committee provided a satisfactory reason is stated on the entry form.
5. Players competing in Albury Pennant matches on Saturday afternoon may request an exemption for Saturday afternoon but **MUST** be available all Saturday morning from 9.00 am. Players granted such an exemption will be allowed to play in 3 events only of which each player will determine.
6. Players remaining in three or more events on the last day may be required to scratch from one event.

### AGE EVENTS

1. Juniors: Age taken as at 31st March 2010.
2. Seniors: Age taken as at 31st December 2010.

### COUNTBACKS

1. In the event of a tie in Round Robin game events, a count back will be completed in order of:
  - a) Sets won, if still tied
  - b) Games won, if still tied
  - c) Games lost, if still tied
  - d) Result between tied entrants

2. In the event of a tie in Round Robin tie break final(s) (if held), a count back will be completed in same order as above with Tie Breaks replacing Sets & Points replacing Games.
  - a) Maximum points won is 7
  - b) Maximum points lost is 5

### TIME

1. Play starts at 9.00am each day. The time draw for the first days play will be available at 5.00pm Thursday 4th March at [www.92computing.com.au](http://www.92computing.com.au).
2. Players must report 15 minutes before their scheduled match time. Failure to play when called may result in disqualification.
3. Seniors Round Robin events will be played on Sunday.

### LENGTH OF MATCHES

1. Open Singles - Best of three tiebreak sets.
2. Open Doubles - Two tiebreak sets, if one set all, 'Match Tiebreak' to be played (first to 10 points).
3. Special Singles - 10 game set (t/b 9 all).
4. All other events - As determined by the tournament committee.
5. The tournament manager has the authority to vary the length of matches &/or amend/change round robin events to knockout in need.

### DRAW SIZE

1. Open Singles (Limited to 64 players).
2. Open Doubles (Limited to 64 pairs).
3. Order of acceptance is determined by the order entries are received &/or the latest Australian Rankings.
4. Events will be seeded by Tennis Victoria using the latest Australian Rankings available.

### CANCELLATION

The committee reserves the right to refuse any player(s) entry &/or cancel any event if the number of entrants is deemed unsatisfactory.

### ELIGIBILITY

Open events are open to all players. Players unsure as to what grade to enter may refer to the following as a broad guideline -

1. Open Events: Pennant Grade 1 - 2
2. Special & A Grade Events: Pennant Grade 3 - 5 (Top 4 Open Seeds ineligible)
3. B Grade: Pennant Grade 6 - 8
4. C Grade: Pennant Grade 9 - 12
5. D Grade: Pennant Player ineligible

### BALLS

The Wilson Australian Open ball will be used exclusively during this event.
